

EUDEC Fee Schedule as per AGM 2011

- All membership fees are annual fees per calendar year
- For chapters in Europe 50% of all fees are for EUDEC, 50% for Chapter
- For chapters in European low-income countries 30% of all fees are for EUDEC, 70% for Chapter
- Chapters with independent legal status must transfer the appropriate portion of the fees they collect to EUDEC once every quarter for members who paid in the previous quarter.
- Chapters without independent legal status are allowed to spend up to their portion of the membership fees collected by EUDEC from members of their chapter for purposes that fall under the aims and objectives specified in the Articles of Association of EUDEC e.V.
- Entities based in the following countries as of World Bank list of 2007 qualify for low-income rules: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Georgia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Turkey and Ukraine.
